Field Progress This Period:


- Continued remedial action activities (surface removal activities).

- Begin reacquisition and subsurface removal activities in Cold Spring and Yellow Springs herbaceous openings.

Days Worked and Exposure Hours (43-46 workers):

- 90 days worked
- 16,423 hours worked












