
Property Information:

The facility sits on approximately 3.33 acres in West Pittston, Luzerne County. The building was constructed in 1959 and is approximately 19,518 Square Feet. It consists of a large drill hall, administrative space, classrooms, kitchen, and multiple storage areas.

Utility costs over a three year period have averaged approximately \$ 17,700 / year.



The readiness center is currently occupied by members of Company D 1st Bn, 109th IN who will be relocating to another facility.

Proposed Action:

Working by and through the Pennsylvania Department of General Services, the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) is actively seeking to dispose of the West Pittston Readiness Center. Conveyances of commonwealth owned readiness centers must be approved by the Pennsylvania General Assembly and the Governor. The commonwealth intends to sell this property for Fair Market Value (FMV) as determined by an independent appraisal. The facility is currently in the process of being appraised.
