

Kane Weekend Training (WET) Site Fact Sheet

South Side, Ash Street
Kane, PA 16735

Property Information:

The property is approximately 2.58 acres situated in the Borough of Kane, McKean County. The site consists of a fenced compound, a large 40 X 50 metal storage building, and several small storage sheds. Its primary use was for the secure storage of military equipment for the local Pennsylvania Army National Guard unit.



Utility costs over a three year period have averaged approximately \$ 1,600 / year.

The weekend training site was utilized by members of the 28 ID/2 IBCT Det 1 Co A – 128th BSB who will be relocating to another facility.

Working by and through the Pennsylvania Department of General Services, the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) is actively seeking to dispose of the Kane weekend training site.
