### **Altoona VA COVID-19 Vaccination Information:**

### **Butler VA Begins COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution With Moderna:**

The Butler VA in Butler County is one of 113 VA Medical Centers across the country to receive the first limited supply of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine. Sites were identified based on need for the vaccine according to CDC's 1A prioritization and capacity to store the vaccine at -20°C. [Website](#).

### **COVID-19 Vaccine Available At Coatesville VA Medical Center:**

Coatesville VA Medical Center in Chester County began offering the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine to outpatients. Coatesville is one of more than 100 VA medical centers and outpatient clinics now offering the Moderna vaccine. As vaccines become available, the VA care team will be reaching out to eligible veterans to schedule vaccinations. If you're eligible to get a vaccine, your VA health care team will contact you. You don't need to reserve a vaccine or come to a VA facility to request or receive a vaccine until you are contacted. The staff will only provide vaccines to veterans who are currently eligible for one based on VA and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) risk criteria. [Website](#).

### **Protect Yourself And Your Loved Ones "“ Get a Flu Shot:**

You can help protect your family from influenza this season by getting a flu shot. In most homes, women are the primary caregivers for their children, grandchildren, parents, spouses or other family members. As a veteran enrolled in VA health care, you can go to your local VA Medical Center, or to one of VA's many Community Care Network (CCN) partners to receive a flu shot at no cost. A measure was included in the final version of the Defense Bill to grant Department of Veterans Affairs benefits to tens of thousands of Vietnam War veterans believed to be suffering the effects of Agent Orange. The final version includes a measure that would approve benefits for Vietnam War veterans suffering from bladder cancer, hypothyroidism and Parkinson's-like symptoms, conditions thought to be caused by exposure to the chemical herbicide Agent Orange. ### **VA Publishes Final Regulation To Improve Delivery Of Prosthetic And Sensory Aids Services:**

The VA published a final rule to establish and clarify eligibility for prosthetic and rehabilitative items and services available to veterans. This establishes for the first time, the nationwide categories of prosthetic and orthotic services, sensory aids and medical devices VA is authorized to provide to veterans as part of their active treatment and ongoing rehabilitation. ### **VA Grows Locations For C&P Contract Exams For Veterans And Service Members:**

The Medical Disability Program Office (MDEO) administers the Medical Disability Exam (MDE) contract program. MDEO contracts allow vendors to provide examinations to veterans and service members who are seeking disability benefits from VA. The goal of the program is to reduce claims processing time by increasing access to examinations. VA will request a contract examination in support of a veteran's claim, if needed. After VA orders an exam, the vendor will contact the veteran by telephone, registered mail, or email to schedule an appointment within three business days of acknowledging the request from VA. ### **Gulf War Illness:**

Three decades later, as many as a third of that population are affected by a cluster of medically unexplained chronic symptoms that have plagued them following their return from deployment. The symptoms can include fatigue, headaches, joint pain, indigestion, bowel discomfort, insomnia, dizziness, respiratory disorders, skin problems and memory impairment. VA clinicians and researchers often call this condition "Gulf War illness" in medical literature. [Website.](#)

## **Development Of New Multi-Use Office Tower In Pittsburgh Will Create Hundreds Of Jobs, Spur Economic Growth In Western Pennsylvania:**

Governor Tom Wolf announced that F.N.B. Corporation will enter into a joint venture with Pittsburgh Arena Real Estate Development LP and the Buccini/Pollin Group to develop the FNB Financial Center, a 26-story, 547,888-square-foot office tower in Pittsburgh, which will create 160 new, high-paying jobs. The company has committed to investing more than \$220 million into the project. The site would bridge the historic Hill District neighborhoods with the central business district, and the developer has committed to achieving more than 45 percent Minority/Woman-Owned Business Enterprise participation in the total development effort.
