TAPP Funding

 TAPP provides funds to hire independent technical consultants to assist TRC/RAB members to understand the scientific and engineering issues pertinent to the installation's environmental restoration activities.



TAPP Process

- 1. TRC/RAB members complete application
- 2. Army National Guard approves or denies application
- 3. Army National Guard procurement procedure
- 4. Independent technical consultant
 - Knowledge of the issues and laws
 - Academic training in a relevant discipline
 - Ability to review, understand, and put technical information into layman's terms
