

25,218 acres located in Tobyhanna, PA




Consists of Tobyhanna State Park and State Game Lands 127

- > 1912 Army acquired land for military training
- Intensive artillery training during World War II
- > 1949 Land transferred to Commonwealth of PA for State Park and Game Lands

Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) at Site

> UXO consist of 37-mm, 75-mm, and 155-mm high explosive and shrapnel artillery rounds

75-mm High Explosive Projectile


Project Partnership and Regulatory Participation

Remedial Investigation

> UXO recovered in impact areas and buffer zones

> 95% UXO found within 12 inches of the ground surface

 Developed munitions response sites corresponding to impact areas and buffer zones

> MRSs designated as having high, low-moderate or low risk



Alt. 3: Surface Removal of UXO with LUCs


Alt. 4: Removal of UXO to One Foot with LUCs

Alt. 5: Removal of UXO to Detection Depth with LUCs

Selected Remedies

MRSs with Low or Low-Moderate Risk - \$2,659,000

- Alternative 2:

 - Community Education



Selected Remedies

MRSs with High Risk - **\$52,345,000**

- Alternative 5:
 Removal of UXO to
 Detection Depth
 - Land Use Controls
 - Recurring Reviews

- Record of Decision signed September 2010
- Remedial Action work to begin in 2011
- 5 to 15 years to complete depending on available funding
