



## Driver's License Designation Information

### Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA)

1. Applicants must have **received a discharge document:**
  - a. DD FORM 214
  - b. NGB FORM 22
  - c. Federal VA Medical ID Card (service connected)
  - d. Retired Military ID

**\* The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs does not consider an Honorable Discharge Certificate to show official character of service.**
2. Applicants must have a character of service **under conditions other than dishonorable:**
  - a. Honorable (HD)
  - b. Under Honorable Conditions (UHC)
  - c. General (GD)
3. If applicants have any of the characters of service listed below, **the applicant DOES NOT qualify:**
  - a. Uncharacterized – **unless** service-connected disability rating from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs or Reservist on Active Duty for training
  - b. Under Other than Honorable Conditions (OTH)
  - c. Bad Conduct (BCD)
  - d. Dishonorable (DD)
4. Applicants **DO NOT qualify if they are on Active Duty AND DO NOT** have a discharge document under conditions listed in #2.
5. Applicants must **self-certify.** Only the applicant may check the Veterans Designation box.
